## **LOCAL WORKSHOPS IMPLEMENTATION**

Between January and May 2025, all partners delivered national training workshops focused on the practical use of Al in vocational education, based on the EDU-Al toolkit.

- ART+INN (Lithuania): Reached **77** VET teachers through in-person sessions held in both urban and rural areas, supporting digital inclusion.
- Edushakers (Belgium): Engaged **15** educators from Leuven-based schools in interactive workshops held at local training venues.
- My Country? Europe. (Italy): Trained **15** VET teachers through sessions tailored to varying digital readiness levels and focused on responsible Al use.









## FINAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

On 15 - 16, May, Edushakers hosted the final international conference in Leuven, Belgium, with the participation of 50 VET professionals, educators, and stakeholders

The event focused on:

- Showcasing project results and the full EDU-Al digital toolkit
- Sharing experiences from the national workshops
- Exchanging practices on integrating AI into VET curricula
- Strengthening the EDU-AI educator network

Participants received printed workshop templates, explored micro-learning modules, and discussed further application of the toolkit in formal and nonformal training contexts.
